

Declaration Of Homestead

George W Proctor

Know all men by those Present, That I, George W. Proctor, a married man, and at the date hereof, residing with my family on the premises herein after described do hereby declare that it is my intention to use and claim as a homestead said premises. Situate, lying and being in the village of Pinegrove in the County of Amador and the State of California. Consisting of a dwelling house, Black Smith Shop and other out buildings thereon. Together with the Piece Parcel or Tract of Land on which the same are erected: together with the Appertenences; bound and described as follows: vis; Commencing at a Pine Tree on the line of this and land of Thos. Cline on the road leading from Volcano to Jackson, thus West to R. C. Walkers line, thence South to the intersection of the Clinton Road and the Amador County Canal Company's Ditch, thence East to one Mr. Umstead's line, thence North to the place of beginning. Adjoining land of R. C. Walker & G S Norris & the Clinton Road on the West: land of Mr. Umstead, R C Walker and Thos. Cline and the Amador Canal Cos ditch on the East and on the North the said Volcano and Jackson Road containing one hundred and sixty acres of land.
